

Secure Wireless :: How to Connect :: Amazon Kindle Fire

Getting Started

When you first start up your Kindle Fire on campus, the HSUWireless-Secure network will not be shown on the list of available Wi-Fi networks. Follow the steps below to connect to the HSUWireless-Secure network.

Note that other Kindle models do not currently support secure wireless network connection.

Step 1: On the home screen, tap the **Gear** icon in the top-right corner of the screen.

Step 2: Tap **Wi-Fi**.

Step 3: Make sure **Wireless Networking** is turned **On** and tap **Add a Network**

Step 4: Configure your device to connect to the HSUWireless-Secure network as follows:

- Enter the Network SSID **HSUWireless-Secure** exactly as written here.
- For Security, tap the down arrow and select **WPA2 EAP**
- For the EAP method, select **PEAP**.
- For Phase 2 authentication, select **MSCHAPV2**.
- For CA certificate, select (unspecified).
- For User certificate, select (unspecified).
- For Identity, enter your [HSU User Name](#) [1].
- Leave the Anonymous Identity box blank.
- For Password, enter your HSU **Password**.
- Tap **Save**.
