

Security :: Protected Information Standards

Humboldt State University has established a set of data protection and security standards that comprise specific configuration settings in order to meet the requirements of the [CSU Data Classification Standards](#) [1] for computers and other storage devices containing [Level 1](#) [2] data. These standards define best practices for the security of computers containing Level 1 data and cover all equipment owned or managed by the University, University Auxiliary, and University Foundation organizations.

All University staff, faculty, auxiliary and foundation employees are required to observe the standards described on the web pages listed below:
